Minutes. (773)

The Minutes of the meeting of 16th. July, 2013 read but were recorded as incorrect and therefore needed to be rectified. They would be presented at the October meeting for approval.

The Minutes of the meeting of 20th. August, 2013 were proposed, seconded and approved.

Matters Arising. (774)

The Salt box outside the Village hall had still not been replaced.

The stone had not been removed from the drain by Dolfeiniog.

The request for a 'No Tipping' sign on the Bull Lane had not been delivered.

Cllr. Thomas agreed to deal with these issues.

The Oak Bench donated by the Community Council to Pontrobert Church was gratefully accepted and arrangements were in place to site the bench in the churchyard. Unfortunately, Llangyniew Church felt they were unable to accept their bench as they did not have a suitable site to locate it. It was, therefore, decided that this bench be sited on the Village Green in Pontrobert.

Cllr. B. Thomas reported the issue regarding the delay re. Delivery of the Community Council Accounts to the Auditors. This had now been dealt with satisfactorily.

Planning. (775)

A letter was received from Natural Resources Wales regarding the Mapping of Common Land and Rights of Way which had now been completed and could be accessed via their web site.

A meeting had been arranged in Pontrobert Village Hall on 24th. September to discuss this and the Community Council were invited to attend. Any information would be brought back to the October meeting of the Council.

Cllr. Gwalchmai informed the Council that the School required the use of the Hall on 17th. December. It was decided to hold the Council Meeting in Llangyniew Old School. Cllr. Thomas would book the Old School.

Cllr. Thomas gave a short report on the review on transport being held by Powys County Council.

Cllr. D. Evans reported a number of pot holes on the road past Rhos Cynhinfa towards Dolanog. Cllr. Thomas agreed to contact Highways.
