- a. Llangyniew Well. The fence around the Llangyniew well was discussed by council and it was decided to contact Mr Selwyn Davies who erected the fence and ask for his comments and job details. - b. Nation Grid-Pylons. Mr Robert Hardy a retired MP is writing a letter on behalf of the local community councils with reference to Pylons (Mid Wales Connection Project) in the local area. The letter will be addressed to the Minister for Local Government. The council is being asked if it would be joint signatures for the letter. It was proposed, seconded and carried that the council agreed such action and subject to consultation with Chairman and vice Chairman.

Clerk was also asked to apply for 4 copies of Environmental Impact Assessment Scoping Report- Mid Wales connection project dated May 2014. **Action Clerk**

- c. The Clerk was instructed to write to Cllr Glyn Watkins congratulating him on his appointment as President of the Llanfair C show. **Action Clerk**

- d. The following Highway issues were raised:
 - (1) It was reported that a hole measuring approx 18” in width and at least 12” deep has been left unmarked on the road at the cross road junction of B4389, B4382 and U2405. This is extremely hazardous to road users. The hole is a result of the work carried out by Severn Trent. **Action Clerk**
 - (2) It was reported that tree branches are overhanging the road on the C2016 above the ford and factory bridge. **Action Clerk**
